AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3 OF THE CITY CODE RELATING TO ANIMAL REGULATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

- **PART 1.** City Code Section 3-1-1 (*Definitions*) is amended to add two new definitions after definition (1) and to renumber the subsequent definitions accordingly:
- (2) BULL HOOK means a tool, also known as an elephant goad or an ankus, used in handling and training elephants, consisting of a spike and hook attached to a shaft or handle.
- (3) CIRCUS means a business that exhibits performances by a company of performers for the purpose of entertaining the public. The term includes the business, its employees, its contractors, and its agents.
- **PART 2.** Chapter 3-2 (*Restrictions on Animals*) is amended to add a new Section 3-2-7 to read:

§ 3-2-7 TREATMENT OF ELEPHANTS IN A CIRCUS

- (A) A circus may not use a bull hook to train or control an elephant.
- (B) A circus may not brandish, exhibit, or display a bull hook in the presence of an elephant.
- (C) A circus may not train or control an elephant by:
 - (1) depriving the elephant of food, water, or rest;
 - (2) electricity;
 - (3) punishing the elephant in a way that results in damage, scarring, or breaking the skin;
 - (4) inserting an instrument into an elephant's bodily orifice; or
 - (5) the use or display of a baseball bat, axe handle, pitchfork, or similar tool.
- (D) This section applies at all times, regardless of whether the elephant is being used in an exhibition by the circus.
